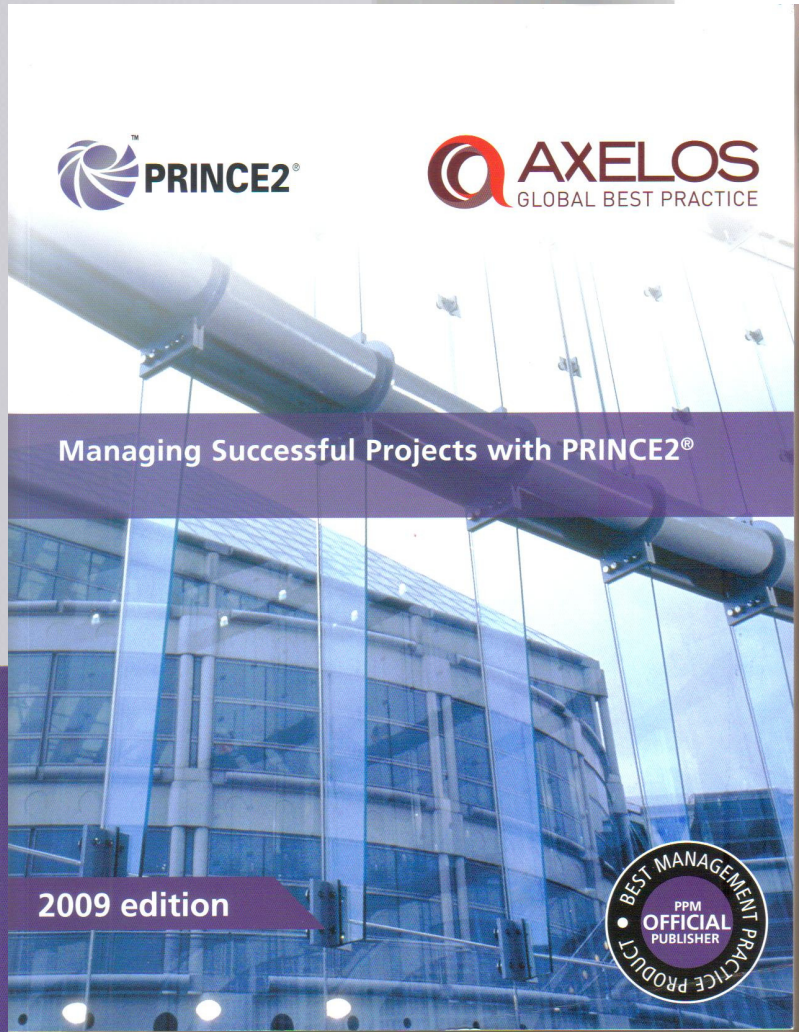


The PRINCE2® Manual.
